Queens Residents Zone Out Congestion Pricing

A poll of registered Democratic voters from the Borough of Queens strong opposition to the unsustainable, unfair, inequitable and regressive toll-tax [scheme](#) known as Congestion Pricing. The *Exclusive Queens Tribune*-commissioned poll surveyed likely (Queens) Democratic voters in the Thursday, September 13, 2018 Primary. The poll, announced September 4, 2018 found that Queens Democratic voters oppose congestion pricing 52 – 29 percent with 19 “unsure.”

Clearly these Queens voters recognize *Congestion Pricing* aka *East River Tolls* aka *Zone Pricing* as a policy idea that [fails](#) here in just about every way:
